



The **SUMMER CAMPING CHECKLIST**

EVERY RV OWNER SHOULD KNOW

A few minutes of prep now can save you hours of stress later.

Stay safe. Camp more. Make memories.



1. CHECK TIRE PRESSURE

Check when tires are cold. Inspect tread and sidewalls. Don't forget the spare!



2. TORQUE YOUR LUG NUTS

Use a torque wrench and check to manufacturer specs, especially if wheels have been removed.



3. TEST YOUR BRAKES

Test your brake controller and check brake response at low speed. Verify breakaway cable.



4. SANITIZE YOUR FRESH WATER HOSE

Inspect the hose, rinse it out, and sanitize if it's been sitting. Clean water is essential.



5. CHECK YOUR BATTERY CHARGE

Check state of charge, clean terminals, and confirm solar is working (if equipped).



6. INSPECT YOUR AWNING

Extend it fully, look for tears or wear, and make sure it retracts smoothly. Never leave unattended.



7. CHECK PROPANE LEVELS

Check tank levels, valves, and hoses for leaks or damage. Don't run out on the road!



8. TEST YOUR SAFETY DETECTORS

Test smoke, carbon monoxide, and propane detectors. Replace batteries as needed.
